## IN THE VINEYARD

100% Grenache. Crafted exclusively from one small vineyard parcel in the Columbia Valley – Thunderstone, whose Perrin family Tablas Creek Clone vines were planted and grown specifically to exude Rosé. This intentionality provides better management of canopy, clusters, shape, and color potential while maximizing ripeness. Over three decades ago, the first vine cuttings were imported from France's Château de Beaucastel, one of Chateauneuf-du-Pape's greatest estates; the Lawrence family secured some of these bench-grafted vines exclusively for this 80-acre site. Situated at a lower elevation for the Royal Slope, Thunderstone capitalizes on warmer days and cooler nights. Fully sustainable and using organic farming methods, whenever possible, this growing season allowed for even and early ripening, yielding solid acid retention while maximizing mouth feel and the development of red fruit aromas.

## WINEMAKING

The grapes were hand-harvested early in the evening of October 4th, 2019, and then de-stemmed and macerated for 24 hours before whole cluster pressing. This longer maceration time allows for flavor enhancement, yielding more citrus and floral potpourri without darkening the color. Fermented using a combination of native yeast in a vast array of small stainless steel tanks and racked off of the gross lees early. White wine specific presses allow for the capturing of maximal aromatics with minimalistic intervention. Over the course of 8 months, this Rose' was individually evaluated over 40 times by our winemaking team, and finally bottled with a light fining and filtration on August 3, 2020.
