

BLACKBOARD 2019 CABERNET SAUVIGNON



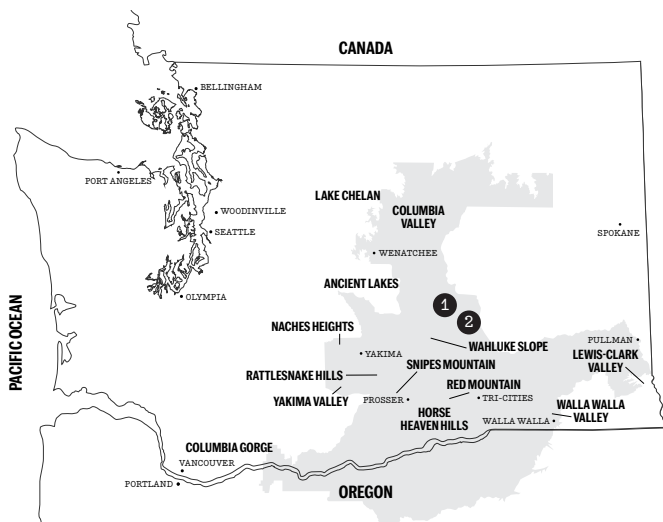
The 2019 Blackboard Cabernet Sauvignon was crafted from two vineyard sites located within Washington State: Conner Lee and Solaksen. Both locations are regarded as two of the top vineyard sites for bordeaux varietals within the entire state, with some of the plantings dating back to 1991. Farmed using sustainable practices, the vines were hand-harvested in the early fall mornings of 2019. Upon arrival at the winery, the wine was fermented and aged in stainless steel tanks, with three months on oak (50% new French oak). The resulting wine was bottled in August of 2021. Only 2,754 cases were produced.

“Beautiful notes of strawberry preserve, blackberries, cinnamon, cocoa powder, milk chocolate, and hints of vanilla bean. A full-bodied wine with round tannins, surprising complexity, and balanced acidity. A great window into a warm vintage here in Washington State.”
