

BLACKBOARD 2019 CABERNET SAUVIGNON



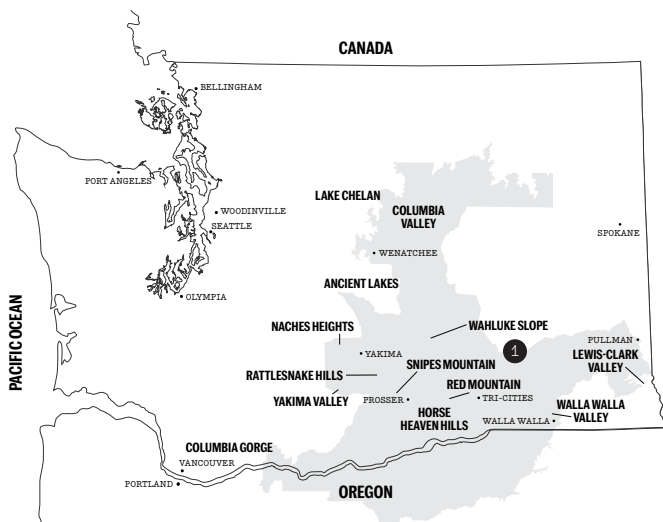
The 2019 Blackboard Cabernet Sauvignon was crafted from a single vineyard from Washington State: Conner Lee (84%) Cabernet Sauvignon (14%) Merlot. Farmed using sustainable practices, the vines were handharvested in the early fall mornings of 2019. Upon arrival at the winery, each cluster was hand-sorted and destemmed. The wine was fermented and aged in stainless steel tanks, with three months on oak (50% new French oak). After extensive evaluation by our winemaking team, 2,754 cases were produced.

“Beautiful notes of, strawberry preserve, blackberries, cinnamon, cocoa powder, milk chocolate, and hints of vanilla bean. A full-bodied wine with round tannins, surprising complexity, and balanced acidity. A great window into a warm vintage here in Washington State.”
